



Youth Educators in STEM (YES)

Building for Kids is expanding the museum's STEM programming to build confidence and interest among older students through a youth mentorship program called *Youth Educators in STEM* (YES). We are developing this program to evaluate confidence in STEM in students of various ages through our museum's STEM lab space.

YES will engage targeted high school participants, who will be acting as mentors to younger children, who are early on in their STEM skills acquisition journey. We are looking for students who might be curious about STEM and STEM-related career opportunities.

Students will support STEM programming and activities in The Lab at the Building for Kids Children's Museum starting in June of 2026.
